Mandated Training

As members of Team Coast Guard there are certain Mandated Training Courses that Auxiliarists must complete. The purpose of Mandated Training is to build awareness and enhance the knowledge, skills, abilities, and attitudes of the Coast Guard's workforce.

Auxiliarists must successfully complete the following Mandated Training during their first year of enrollment and then once every five years thereafter:

DHS Together - Resilience Training - Course code 502379
Sexual Harassment Prevention - Course code 810000
Sexual Assault Prevention and Response - Course code 810045
Civil Rights Awareness - Course code 502319
Security Education and Training Awareness (SETA) – course code 810030
Privacy at DHS / Protecting Personal Information - Course code 810015

Auxiliarists must successfully complete the following Mandated Training only once (new members shall complete them during their first year of enrollment):

Ethics 1 / Personal Gifts - course code 502306
Influenza Training - course code 502290

The Flotilla will offer some of these Mandated Training Courses at meetings over the coming year but the most efficient way for members successfully complete the courses is to log in to AUXLMS and take the courses online.
