- Your "Highway" Signs • Rules of the Nautical Road
- Inland Boating • Boating Safety • Intro to Navigation
- Powering your Boat • Lines and Knots
- Weather and Boating • Your Boat's Radio

Students receive a National Association of State Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA) certificate of completion of the course.

- Nautical Charts • Dead Reckoning
- Piloting • Current Sailing
- Tides and Tidal Currents • Road Navigation
