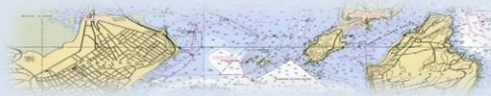
**Weekend Navigator**

Weekend Navigator will focus on navigation in the digital age, along with the timeless techniques of classical navigation so that you never have to rely solely on electronics.

You will learn how to use such tools as a GPS receiver and chart plotter as well as read nautical charts, plot courses, take bearings and the other techniques upon which all navigation is based. The course materials including textbook and training charts are included in the course fee.

Prerequisite: NASBLA approved safe boating course. Relevant experience can satisfy this requirement with prior approval of the course coordinator.
